- Photos should be high resolution (3650 pixels x 2740 pixels and landscape orientation is preferred).
   Generally, photos taken with mobile phones are not high-enough quality to be featured as monthly photos.
- Entries can be submitted online starting July 20 12:01am, and ending August 9 at 5:00pm CDT.
- Entries can be submitted in person at Parkway Place Mall, or by mail, and must be received by 5:00 pm CDT on August 9, 2015.




