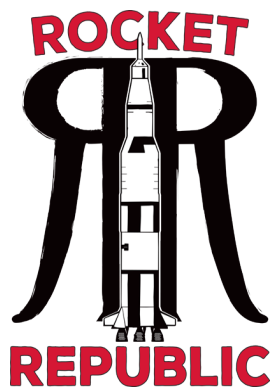

The 14th Annual Hot Dogs & Cool Cats Pet Photo Contest opens for entries and voting on Friday July 6th at 5:00pm CDT.

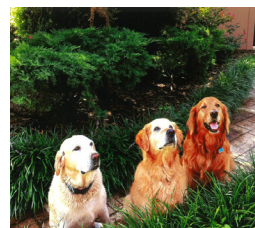
- \$25 Entry fee per photo


