In June, GHHS in partnership with South Huntsville Veterinary Hospital launched the Monte's Wellness Clinic, a low-cost routine care program for our area residents. Over the course of the first seven months, Monte's clinic provided vaccines, microchips, preventatives and heartworm tests to 110 pets, from 77 households.

These efforts were provided by an anonymous donor, Monte's owner, that helped finance the first six months of efforts.

In addition, GHHS provided 131 spay and neuter procedures and 52 emergency medical vouchers to community-owned pets through our Good Samaritan Fund—investing a total of \$20,504.63 to support our neighbors and community owned pets.
